(-ing, -ed, -er, -en) Suffixes -ation, -ly, -ous</p> <p>Homophones/near homophones no/know, write/right, wear/where, ball/bawl, brake/break, fair/fare, great/grate, here/hear, heal/heel/he'll, not/knot, mail/male, meet/meat, medal/meddle, missed/mist, plain/plane, scene/seen, weather/whether, bear/bare, weak/week, be/bee</p> <p>Orange words</p> <p>Use the first two or three letters to check the spelling of words in a dictionary</p>	<p>Can I choose the correct lines to join letters?</p> <p>Do I know which letters are best left unjoined?</p>	<p>Can I choose the correct determiner 'a' or 'an' before a noun?</p> <p>Can I choose the correct pronouns?</p>	<p>Are most of my sentences punctuated correctly using capital letters, and correct punctuation at the end? . ? !</p> <p>Can I join clauses using conjunctions 'when', 'before', 'after', 'while', 'so', 'if', 'although' and 'because'?</p> <p>Can I give more detail in a sentence using prepositions such as 'during', 'in', 'on', 'beyond', 'through', 'near', and 'beside'?</p> <p>Can I give information in a sentence about when, where, and how the verb is 'done' using an adverb?</p> <p>Am I beginning to use inverted commas to punctuate direct speech?</p> <p>Am I beginning to use paragraphs to organise ideas?</p> <p>Can I use the features of different text types in my writing?</p>
